

# Birthday wishes from Kathleen Falk Designs

This Birthday cake box is a very simple box to assemble. Simply cut around outside edge, score on lines (scoring is the process of using a ruler and a blunt end pointed object to go over lines so that they will fold easily) and fold. Glue or tape flaps to adjoining section inside. Cut out candle and insert in a cut line you make on top of box.



The candle at the bottom is optional. Assemble this bottom just as you did the top of the cake, and after assembly it should slide right into the top of the cake box for either more stability if you are using lightweight paper, or just as the bottom of the box to perhaps hold a small gift. If you want it to look like a two layer cake, simply do not slide it all the way into the top. You can make it stay that way by adding a 1" extension to opposing sides on the top edge of box bottom.
